You have been accepted to the Faculty of Dentistry of Montpellier and we are happy to welcome you!

Here is some information regarding your stay and our Faculty.



1. THE FACULTY

Location and access

The Faculty of Odontology of Montpellier is located at 545, Avenue du Pr. Jean-Louis Viala.

It is accessible by Streetcar - Line 1 - Direction Mosson, stop "Hauts de Massane".

CROUS university restaurant

The university restaurant/cafeteria is located on the main floor of Building A. Lunch is available from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. A meal costs approximately $3.30 \in$ (starter, main course, dessert). The cafeteria is open from 8 a.m. to 1:45 p.m.

Payment is made with the student card (IZLY)

• University Library

Opening hours:

Monday to Thursday, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The library is located on the first floor of Building A.

Books and journals can be borrowed with a student ID card. It also has a photocopying area. Several computer stations have internet access.

A large medical library is located at the Faculty of Medecine, Campus Santé Arnaud de Villeneuve (=UPM), Streetcar line no. 1 : Occitanie.



• The Dental Care Center (CHU)

The Dental Care Center (CSD) is the hospital where you will complete your clinical internships. It is located right next to the Faculty.



• Internet access

The entire estblishment is equipped with Wi-Fi. To connect your devices to its network, you must activate your ENT account.

• Private accommodation

If you are not staying in a university residence, we advise you to look for accommodation near streetcar line 1 as soon as possible

It is very difficult to find accommodation in September.

Home insurance is mandatory in France.

This insurance will need to be taken out when you are in France.

To help you pay your rent, the Family Allowance Fund (CAF) can grant you financial assistance.

• International Student/Researcher Reception Service

Banque



It is recommended to open an account with a French bank. This will allow you to receive your salary, financial assistance from the CAF (Family Allowance Fund), etc. You will need to provide your bank account details (RIB). Ask your bank for them or print them directly from an ATM .



2. OPERATION OF THE CLINIC



• Some information

One clinical session = one half-day of clinical practice (8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. or 2:00 p.m. - 6:00p.m.)

Upon arrival at the Care Center, you will be introduced to the managers of the Dental Care Center :

Professor Bernard LEVALLOIS, Head of Departement;

Mr. Richard LE DOUARIN, Nurse Manager of the departement.

During clinical sessions, students work in pairs;

You will need to note in your internship logbook (provided by the Faculty) all the actions carried out, and have each action signed by the responsible teacher;

If you wish to attend to or assist to specific procedures, such as implantology, surgery or orthodontics, you must indicate this at the start of your stay so that we can put you in touch with the responsible teachers.

Timetable

Upon arrival, you will receive a specific schedule, corresponding to your clinical activity



• Equipement to bring



A pair of clean shoes to be used only at the Care Center;

A combination lock to secure your locker;

Ideally: bring with you a bowl and spatula for alginate, as well as a bowl, spatula, and knife for plaster.
